All classes are held upstairs in the library at Clifton Hill PS - in the new building. There is a lift which is located to the left of the stairs.

Scholarships

We are getting closer to the time when our Year 6 students will be taking their exams. Check the websites of the schools in which you are interested so that you are aware of application formats and dates. We are running Saturday classes for final preparations and our Year 5s have started their journey.

Fees Term 1 - 6 week only program

Weekday Classes:

Southern Cross & Middle Park students - \$132 per student per term.

Students from other schools, including Greythorn, \$140 per child (\$135 per child for attending families of 2+ children).

Saturday classes:

\$132 per student per term. (\$130 per child for attending families of 2+ children).

Also NOTE that the Saturday dates start at Camelot and finish at Clifton Hill to avoid the Clifton Hill Annual Fair (we hope!)
